2020 Opportunities and Beyond

Go2020

One of the most exciting projects for the coming year is Go2020, which is an unprecedented movement of Christians from around the globe praying and sharing Jesus with at least one person in the month of May (2020). Due to the successful distribution and outcomes being seen around the world, the resources you've helped to be translated and printed for children have now been adopted for the Go2020 Kids Initiative. Because of the achievement in partnership, ministries have contacted us to help scale up to empower 50 million children worldwide by the end of 2020! Imagine the impact of 50 million prayer-saturated, multiplying disciples reaching family, friends and their communities, praying in power for God to work in people's hearts and minds.

NEW YORK and Beyond

Throughout the five boroughs of New York City, we have partnered with David Beidel, President of Saturate NY, who oversees outreach to 2,500 churches. His vision is to see one million children reached with the Prayer Covenant resources in 2020. We were able to provide him with over 200,000 Children's Prayer Covenant resources, and we hope to supply more in the coming year to reach more children. After New York, plans are in process to start outreaches in Philadelphia (Northeast) and in Denver (Midwest). As doors continue to open and we have the resources to provide, we will continue to expand out across our nation.

MIDDLE EAST

It is thrilling to see God opening doors in primarily Muslim countries. We are honored to have been asked to partner with an amazing outreach called Matthew & Friends. It is a partnership between the Christian Broadcasting Network, One Hope and The Prayer Covenant. This initiative seeks to reach 600,000 children in Pakistan with prayer and the gospel message by the end of 2019.

SE ASIA

Our assistance and resources are being requested by Campus Crusade leadership in Southeast Asia, Carol and Ricky Magno, in order to train 10,000 leaders to disciple 500,000 children in 10 Southeast Asian countries over the next couple of years.

Translation of Prayer Covenant resources are needed in Cambodia, East Timor, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam, China and Korea.

In 2019, we were able to supply our newest translation, Bahasa, for Indonesia. Many more translations are in the works.

Our newest partners, Tim and Naomi Gillette with King's Kids International (YWAM) also requested our resources and are helping with translation and to mobilize leaders in SE Asia, China, Taiwan, Japan and Brazil.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

The vision of GO2020 Kids will be shared at The World Evangelical Alliance that will be held in Indonesia where leaders of national church networks from 130 nations will gather. Becky and Rick Olmstead, the 4 to 14 Window Movement Global Leaders, and Tom Victor, President of the Great Commission Coalition, leading the GO2020 children and youth track, and on our Board of Reference, will also attend the conference. Hosted by Bethel Church International, the church has 300,000 members in Jakarta alone and 3,000,000 throughout Indonesia. I had the opportunity to share The Prayer Covenant with Dr. Abraham Lalemantik and his team last month at this church. He then invited me back during the World Evangelical Alliance gathering to train their top children's leaders.

In addition to faithful supporters like yourself, we could not achieve anything without our global partners and network which continue to reach out to us for training and resources to reach children. Here are a few results of these growing relationships.

- In January 2020, The Prayer Covenant has been asked to provide training for Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF) leaders in Dallas, Texas. We pray this will open more doors with CEF as they disciple 25,000,000 children globally.

- We are grateful for a deepening relationship with One Hope leaders. To date, One Hope has reached over one billion children with the Word of God and we are looking forward to supplying resources with them in the Matthew and Friends project in Pakistan. In addition to our current resources, we worked with Every Home for Christ on the new Lost Sheep Prayer Covenant "engager" to help draw countless boys and girls into a life-giving relationship with their Heavenly Father. Translation has already begun!

- Our partnership with The Jesus Film has resulted in abundant fruit in Africa. The combination of using the Prayer Covenant with The Jesus Film have resulted in 547,000 children disciplined alone, 3,500 leaders trained, and 122,450 decisions for Christ in the quarter from July 1 through September.

As more organizations reach out to us for training and resources, the need to build capacity within our organization in order to supply the needs continues to grow. As we enter into a new decade, we anticipate that God is going to open doors above and beyond what we may ask or think. Your financial and prayer support is needed more than ever.
