Immeasurably more - what an incredible promise from our Lord and Savior. And The Prayer Covenant is experiencing it - not in the way the world measures more; not in financial resources, but in life-giving fruit that will last throughout eternity. God blessed us with an incredible group of gifted leaders passionate about reaching the children and youth of their nations for Jesus Christ. Many of our leaders have been with us since the early years of the Prayer Covenant (TPC) for Children. Their faithfulness and commitment is bearing abundant fruit.

TPC isn't about passing out prayer cards or distributing resources to children at a one-off event. It is about discipleship—day in and day out—reaching and teaching children in some of the most vulnerable communities abroad and here at home. If there was ever a time our children needed to know and understand the teachings of Jesus Christ—to learn His character—His love, grace, compassion, forgiveness... it is now. The confusion over identity; the immoral, twisted teaching our children are receiving is demonic and a deadly trap by Satan that will lead to an eternity of separation from God. It's critical to remember, "Children don't know who they are until they know Whose they are."

I was once asked, "How do you know the teaching will last?" My answer is the same, There is no intimacy with God without prayer. When you disciple the heart of a child—connecting them to the One who has all power—teaching them to pray all God desires for them, He will become the One they run to and their best friend.

MAKING DISCIPLES AMONG THE CHILDREN AND THE YOUTH OF THE NATIONS



"Barna said the coming five years represent a prime time for biblical Christians to add direction and value to culture by strategically and intentionally introducing God's ways and truths into what is presently a turbulent cultural moment.

...Over the past 30 years, belief in the God of the Bible—a loving, omnipotent, and morally unyielding being—has sharply declined. Currently, about half of U.S. adults believe in the biblical God, but fewer worship or follow Him. The fastest-growing faith segment, the "Don'ts," includes those who don't know, believe, or care about God's existence.... Barna began measuring worldview in the 1990s, the incidence of a biblical worldview in America has steadily declined, with just 4% of adults, 2% of parents of preteens, 1% of teenagers, and only 37% of Christian-church pastors holding a biblical worldview. Meanwhile, Syncretism—a worldview blending multiple philosophies for personal satisfaction—dominates, with 92% of Americans adhering to it—a trend that is likely to grow as biblical teaching loses cultural influence."

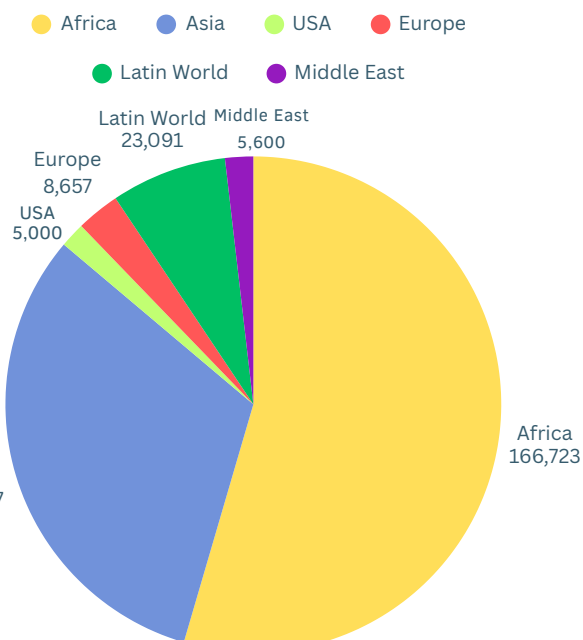

AFRICA

We are excited to celebrate the fifth year of Last Quarter Evangelism (LQE) on the African continent.

Once again, multitudes of children and youth were equipped and mobilized throughout 39 countries in Africa to share the gospel through various evangelistic outreaches.

LQE takes place each year from October 1st to December 31st, in partnership with All Africa Baptist Fellowship (AABF) and GO Movement. It was birthed from the prayers of children in 2020 and since then has been faithfully leading evangelistic outreaches throughout Africa each year.

This year the theme was, *“Jesus is the Living Water,”* taken from John 4:14 and 15.

It was implemented through one-on-one gospel sharing and/or inviting people to church as well

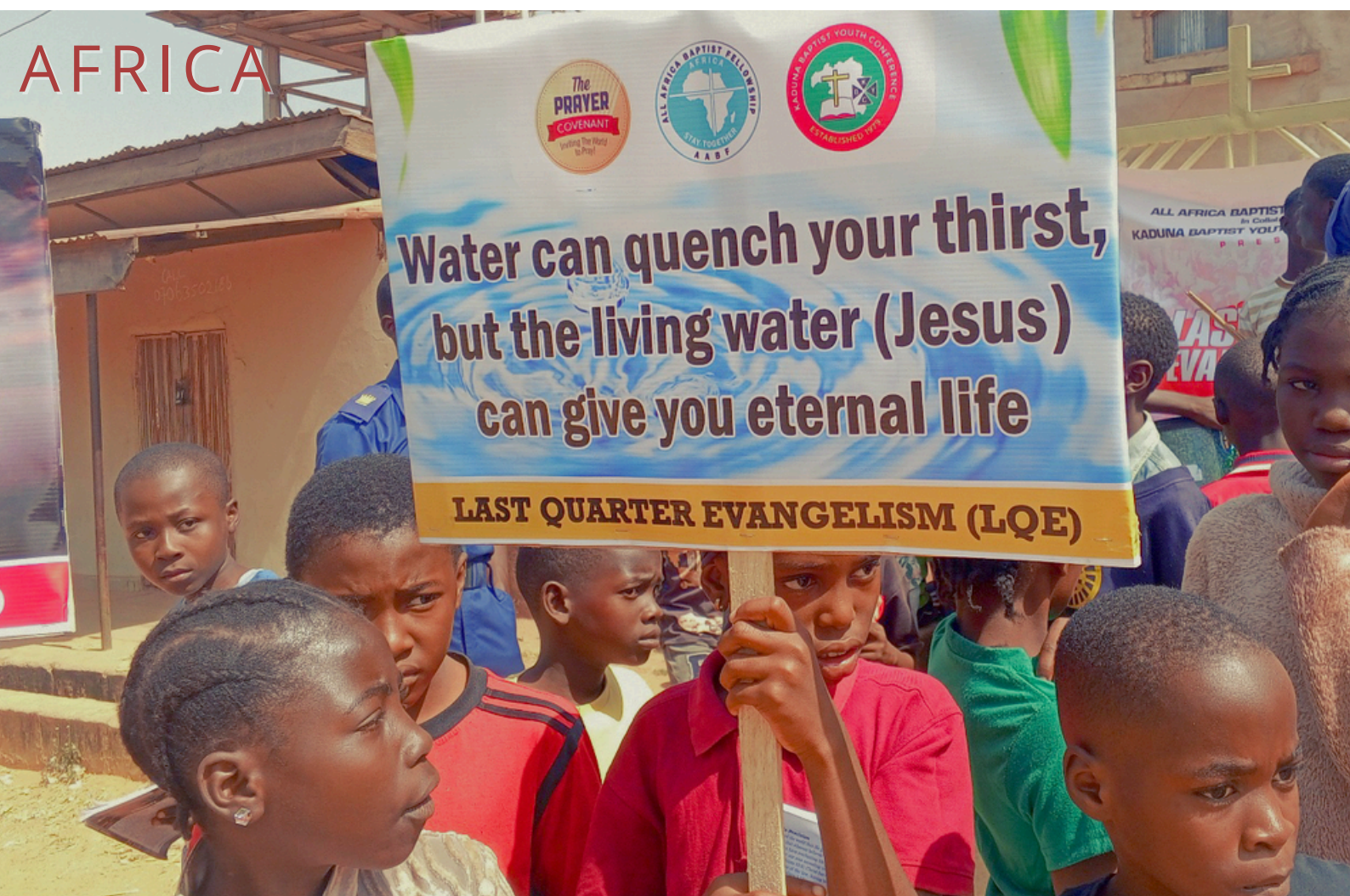
as group activities like door-to-door evangelism, hospital visits and in the front yard or forecourts of churches so they could share the Gospel with those who passed by.

Three categories of people were involved in these outreaches: children’s ministry leaders, child evangelists and children intercessors.

For example, in Kaduna, Nigeria, over 200 children under five years of age were able to carry out the forecourt evangelism model and preach to passers-by, singing songs of salvation with joy to attract other children and the community at large. LQE demonstrated the incredible power of God through young people.

Men and women were moved to tears as children boldly proclaimed the Gospel of Jesus Christ through their streets.

The events sparked a spiritual awakening—stirring gifts in the children and opening new doors for future missional activities.

CONVERSION STORY OF KADIJAH

"There is no reason for us to cease thanking the Lord for His gift of The Prayer Covenant ministry. Our children are becoming powerful instruments of the Gospel of Christ. We are surprised by places where they are capable of stepping in for souls winning. Places where adults have no chance to talk about their faith, children have no limit. In our outreach with children, they shared their faith with Fullah children. Fullah are known as a highly Muslim people. Kadijah is part of these Fullah children. After some days, she reached out to the Spouse of Rev. Mark. She said that she is now a secret Christian believer. Because as a teenager, she has no opportunity to choose her religion. She said she will keep pretending going to Mosque until she stands on her own. She wished she could attend our teenagers' retreat on the 8th- 10th November, 2024, but she didn't received permission from her parents. We are motivated and encouraged to see how the Lord is using children to save people. It is the outcome of the resources they got out of The Prayer Covenant teachings and resources." In 2024, Pakistan Sunday School ministry, our partner since 2018, has equipped children and youth workers, through training courses and much needed resources to effectively lead Sunday schools and youth groups. The trained leaders organized sports and games outreach events for the children of all age groups across the country focusing on areas still unreached with the Gospel, promoting their holistic development. In 2023, the Jaranwala Incident involved a devastating attack on over 100 Christian families, where homes and churches were burned, leaving the community displaced and traumatized. In response to the Jaranwala incident, it was provided spiritual care, material support and community engagement. Through the Kids TV ministry, thousands of children and youth nationwide were reached, fostering evangelism and discipleship across communities.

In 2024: 1,243 ministry workers received TPC training and 20,927 children were discipled through TPC programs and resources. Children received 25,844 booklets and 26,013 prayer cards.

TESTIMONY FROM A PASTOR

*"My name is Daud Shahzad, and I serve as a Pastor at Philadelphia Pentecostal Church Rawalpindi. Our church oversees four Sunday Schools in different neighborhoods. Recognizing that many of our young students were hesitant to pray, I consistently encouraged our teachers to emphasize the significance and power of prayer. Fortunately, we connected with the Pakistan Sunday School Ministry, who provided valuable training for our teachers and introduced us to "The Prayer Covenant". **This curriculum proved to be incredibly effective. After implementing the new approach, I observed a remarkable transformation in the children of our Sunday schools. They now pray confidently and naturally, without any hesitance. The Prayer Empowerment Program has profoundly strengthened the prayer life of our children. I am deeply grateful to PSSM for introducing us to TPC for fostering such a positive change in our young learners.**"*



TESTIMONY FROM A CHILD

"My name is Neha, and I am 12 years old, living in small town. I used to think that everything happens according to God's plan and will, so I wondered why we needed to pray. My perspective changed when my Sunday school teacher taught us about the importance of prayer from "The Prayer Covenant" booklet. My teacher explained that prayer is a powerful weapon in our spiritual battles against challenges, hardships and temptations. Teacher also taught us that while God is the creator of everything and His will guides all things, prayer is our way to communicate directly with Him. From "The Prayer Covenant," I learnt that even a simple, one-sentence prayer holds great significance if it's offered sincerely and with faith. Now I understand that prayer is a vital part of our lives and have found the answer to my question, "Why should we pray?"



INDIA



We are immensely grateful to God for the growing impact of the Prayer Covenant in India. With the help of our local partners, over the last few years, nearly half a million children have been reached and discipled in India through The Prayer Covenant. Our India team is focused on raising awareness of TPC so that every church adopts and includes it in their Sunday School curriculum. Each year tens of thousands of Christian children are mobilized to share the gospel with their non-Christian friends and invite them to Teens Club and church. Children were able to use TPC prayer cards to find prayer partners and share their spiritual journey. Churches have been able to move beyond Sunday school. **Teen clubs and youth clubs have been adopted as a result of Prayer Covenant initiatives in many Churches.**

Some churches have experimented for the first time with children becoming missionaries, able to influence and engage their non-Christian friends and parents, which has led to an increase in the number of those attending Sunday school.

TESTIMONY FROM A CHILD

"My name is Ramya I am studying 8th class. I go to a children's program at a church near my house. There they will tell the story of the song and then we will all play together. They taught me how to talk to the Jesus like father. I started praying by saying the words on this prayer card.

Now I pray daily. I pray both morning and evening. I told my mother about this and we are praying together. I have told my friends. Sometimes I pray with them too."



TESTIMONY FROM A CHILD



"My name is Gayathri, I am studying in 6th standard, I attended a children's program last week. Everything they said was good and they told about Jesus through the puppet. He came into the world for me and died on the cross for my sins and forgave all my sins and I believe that. Now I have become Jesus' child. Jesus taught us to make a prayer covenant with the Father and I say and pray that prayer agreement every day. I feel happy when I finish praying. I know a change in me. I have been telling my friends about the prayer I have learned. Thank you Father Jesus."

Since we began our work in the Middle East in 2017, our partners have been conducting training and discipleship work in sensitive countries across the

Another training took place at another location that we cannot mention for security reasons, to provide house church leaders with The Prayer Covenant programs. 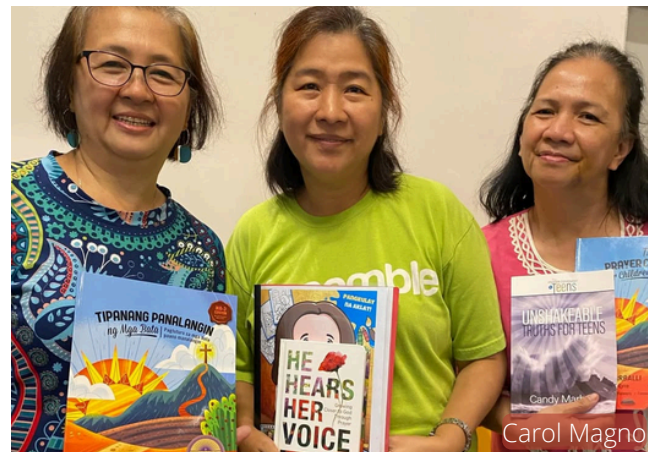


A conversation that started at the GACX Forum 2019, has now led to a partnership that has seen over 400 connections between churches, ministries, and volunteers across the Philippines and 10 countries across Southeast and South Asia. In 2019, Carol with Global Church Movements (GCM) was praying for God's leadership as to how to involve the children in prayer mobilization, a prompting related to the Great Commission. The Prayer Covenant for Children authored by Candy Marballi became God's answer to prayer. The curriculum written in language appropriate for children's age, showed the Bible-based, gospel-focused prayer is a series of lessons progressing toward discipling children in Christ-centered prayer. Learning the character and attributes of the Lord became the discipleship path for the children. As children are being discipled toward becoming faithful, prayerful, and joyful followers of the Lord Jesus, they are empowered to share the gospel in their heart language across generations. Carol has seen children being able to disciple other children, sharing the gospel with adults their parents, and even their grandparents.

As the children appropriate the filling of the Holy Spirit, their disposition and behavior changes

has led adults to ask what has caused these changes in their children's lives.

The local churches have surge of energy toward discipling children. More are seeing them as missional field and becoming little laborers in the mission. Churches are moving from "accommodating the children" mode to "welcoming and empowering the children" mode.



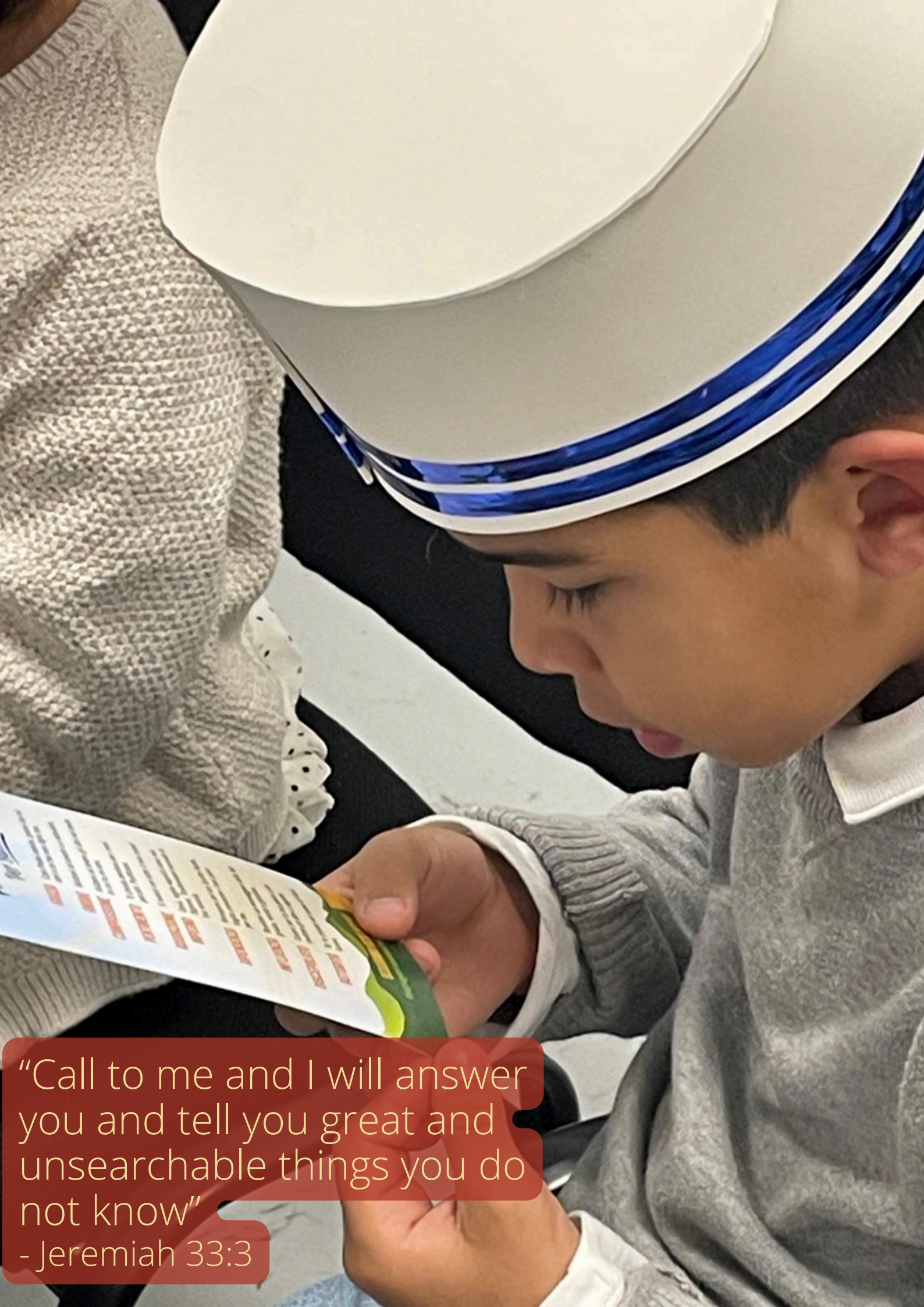
What started with a conversation between two women, has now resulted in collaboration across multiple organizations, local churches, and volunteers to help minister to the people across Southeast and South Asia. Sharing the vision and meeting one another's needs has enabled indigenous believers to translate prayer lessons into local dialects, distribute resources, and map parts of cities and countries where they can go next to continue the discipleship process. These shared efforts have resulted in the multiplication of the Church across 11 countries in Southeast and South Asia (SESA) and beyond. Just last spring, a missionary with Operation Mobilization from Zambia was trained in these prayer lessons and began using them in Zambia to reach children there! Please join us in praying for the efforts of these ministries. For their continued effectiveness in discipling the children and people of the region and for their vision of seeing the Church grow across all 7,000 of the islands of the Philippines and across Southeast and South Asia."

EUROPE

The Prayer Covenant's pioneering work in Italy began in March 2022, and soon after doors to the ministry began to open in other European countries. 2024 was a year of fruitful collaborations for evangelism and training.

Thanks to the partnership with missionary organizations in Italy (ACP, Christ is the Answer) hundreds of unchurched children and teenagers, from other religious backgrounds (Buddhist, Islamic, Atheist, and even from LGBTQ families) received Christ and were disciplined in the first 5 themes of TPC during summer sports and English camps in different regions, and about 1500 children were reached throughout Italy during itinerant evangelistic campaigns from April to September.

The training and discipleship work also continued in various parts of Italy in local churches, to support parents, leaders and children's workers.



Work on translating resources into several European languages (Polish, Romanian, German) also continued, and training courses began in other countries.

In February 2024, the TPC was launched in Switzerland, for now in the Italian part, until the German resources are completed.

While we are looking for national ministry partners in Germany and planning for the first launch event in the Berlin area in fall 2025, Hanna and Päivi, two leaders of the Healingrooms Kids team led by our TPC national director Eva Sarsa in Finland, held a workshop at a large conference, attended by 2,000 people, in central Finland. Their workshop focused on activating families to think about praying together in different ways. They shared the Prayer Covenant tool, inspiring many families.

At the end of August, Carmen Nocera, TPC Vice President and Europe Director, held a national conference on The Prayer Covenant at the University of Theology and Sociology (WSTS) in Warsaw, Poland. Numerous children's ministry leaders from all over Poland attended the training both in person and online, representing 60 churches of different denominations from 40 cities. We received a great response from leaders and pastors who recognize the need to get serious with the new generation and equip children in prayer discipling them in the 10 pillars of TPC.

The worship was different than usual, we consolidated the words that the children learned during the last "popcorn" prayer with a song. To sum up the topic of Grace, a video about "The Good Shepherd" was played and after the movie

we focused on analyzing it. The children remembered a lot from the previous lesson. Then we made sheep; the children ate popcorn from bowls. We finished our time with a rap. Each child received an instrument and we played the rhythm at the right time..." (Children's Church Movement, Krakow)

"Today, I learned to forgive, to tell the truth, not to be a liar. I need to repent."

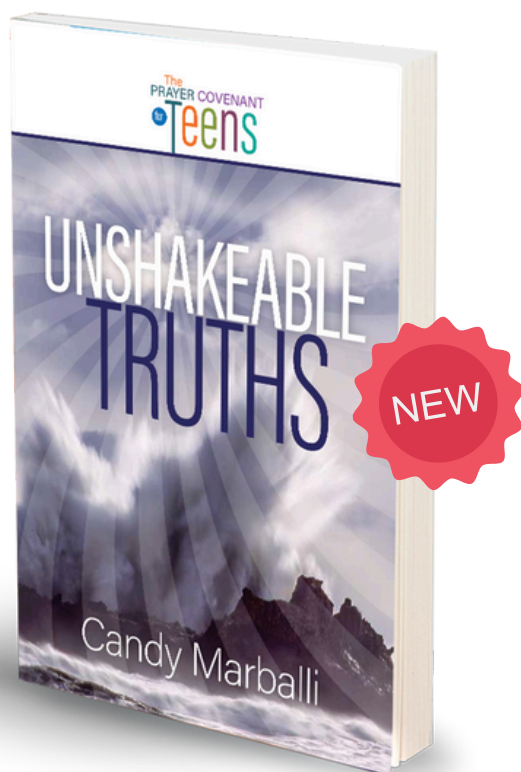


TESTIMONY FROM A PARENT - COLOMBIA

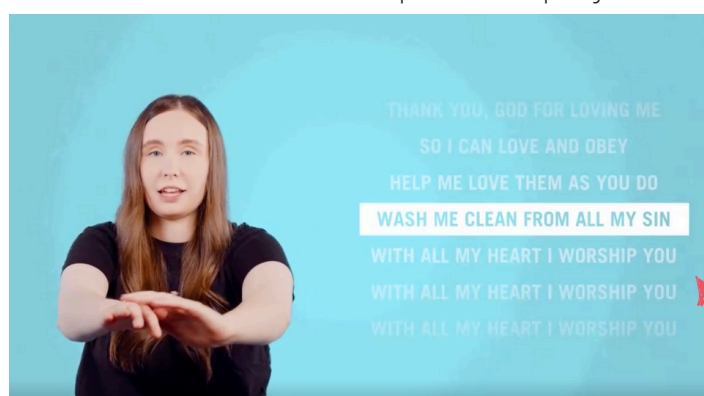
NEW RESOURCE: THE PRAYER COVENANT FOR PRESCHOOLERS
